This camp is aimed at Riding Club members who want to develop their riding skills, both on the flat and over fences, and who wish to take the opportunity of the superb facilities at MKEC and our excellent resident trainers— Jane Hussell & Rebecca Finn.

Meet up with old friends or make some new ones. Our residential camp will start on Friday afternoon and run until after Sunday lunch and includes four lessons in small groups. You can choose between pure flatwork or flatwork with jumping (SJ and XC available).

After last year's successful first MKRC Camp we're expecting this year to be even more popular – so don't delay and book your place today!

**Programme for the weekend:**

Arrive Friday for your first flat work lesson for the instructors to get to know you and your horse. Friday evening there will be a PIMMS welcome reception and getting to know everyone session!

Saturday will include 2 lessons and an evening BBQ (families and guests welcome at additional charge).

Sunday morning will be your final lesson before you pack up and head home after lunch.

Hacking is also available from MKEC if required.

**What's included in the camp?**

- 4 lessons (flat or mix of flat and Jumping)
- Stabling for the horse (with shavings bedding), you will need to bring your own hay/haylage of this can be purchased on site for £4.50 per hay bale of £7.50 per haylage bale.
- Riders will be camping in lorries / tents (or local B&B) and have access to a large club house to stay warm and drink tea/coffee.
- Friday PIMMS welcome drinks, evening meal, Saturday breakfast, lunch and evening BBQ (extra BBQ tickets available at £7 each), Sunday breakfast and lunch. Onsite catering provided by TNI BAR & Catering solutions to ensure you are kept well-fuelled!

**What do you need to bring:**

- Everything for you and your horse (including tools for mucking out etc)
- Snacks and alcohol!

**Costs:**

£220 per person

Additional non riding campers can be added to your booking at a cost of £50 per person (this will include all their food for the weekend).

\* Please note this camp is aimed at MKRC members, non-members are welcome as a guest of an MKRC member at an additional charge of £20 per person
